Brief summary: Please consult full package insert for more information. **Indications:** INTERCEPTOR® (milbemycin oxime) Flavor Tabs™ tablets are indicated for use in the prevention of heartworm disease caused by *Dirofilaria immitis*, the control of adult *Ancylostoma caninum* (hookworm), and the removal and control of adult *Toxocara canis* (roundworm) and *Trichouris vulpis* (whipworm) infections in dogs and in puppies four weeks of age or greater and two pounds body weight or greater. **Precautions:** Prior to initiation of the Interceptor Flavor Tabs treatment program, dogs should be tested for existing heartworm infections. Mild, transient hypersensitivity reactions manifested as labored respiration, vomiting, salivation and lethargy may occur after treatment of dogs carrying a high number of circulating microfilariae. **Adverse Reactions:** The following adverse reactions have been reported following the use of INTERCEPTOR: depression/lethargy, vomiting, ataxia, anorexia, diarrhea, convulsions, weakness, and hypersalivation. **Caution:** U.S. Federal law restricts this drug to use by or on the order of a licensed veterinarian. **How supplied:** Interceptor Flavor Tabs is available in four tablet sizes: 2.3 mg, 5.75 mg, 11.50 mg, and 23.0 mg. They are formulated according to the weight of the dog. Internal parasites are a common problem among dogs, but because there are few outward signs, they often go undetected. That's why experts agree that ongoing parasite control is better for your dog than treating a serious parasite infection after it develops.

HEARTWORMS

Heartworms are the most life-threatening of all canine parasites. These worms, which can reach a length of 14 inches, live in the heart of the dog, putting stress on the heart, restricting blood flow to the organs, and causing organ failure which can lead to death.



Since heartworm is transmitted from dog to dog by mosquitoes, virtually all dogs are at risk. All dogs must be tested for possible heartworm infection before starting a preventive routine.

HOO KWORMS

Hookworms attach to the dog's intestinal lining with hook-like teeth and feed on the dog's blood. Their eggs are released into the dog's intestine and passed through the feces. The eggs then hatch into larvae which can be swallowed by another dog, or can penetrate through the dog's skin. Hookworms cause blood loss, which can sometimes be fatal to puppies.

ROUNDWORMS

Almost all puppies are born with this intestinal parasite, or acquire it through their mother's milk. Older dogs can also become infected through contact with soil containing roundworm eggs. Infected dogs often have rough coats, bloated bellies and suffer from diarrhea and vomiting.



WHIPWORMS

These parasites live in the large intestine and cecum of dogs, and can cause diarrhea, weight loss and dehydration. A problem practically everywhere in the United States, they are very difficult to detect and also to eliminate. That's why it's so important to provide your dog with ongoing protection against whipworm infection. Interceptor® (milbemycin oxime) Flavor Tabs™ is the only monthly heartworm preventive that also controls whipworm.
